This document describes the approach needed in Race Director for non-binary.

## The Race Director

### Non Binary

Race Director has been enhanced to support 3 values for gender – M, F and X. Gender X will be referred to as “Non Binary” in all Race Director reporting and for all results publishing that support a Non Binary gender choice.

The implementation is simple. When you establish Age Groups, use this choice for all races where you will have participants with gender X.
